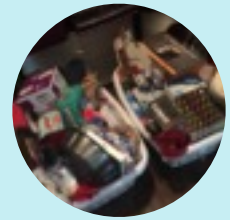
A Growing Club

A Semester in Review

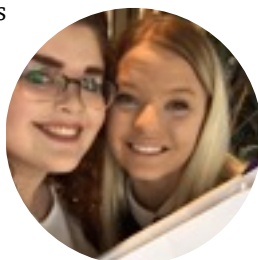
Check out this list to take a quick peek at all our club did this semester!
